

## **SCHOOL RESULTS 2025**

The information below compares the attainment of our pupils with local authority and national averages.

### **Early Years Foundation Stage**

Good Level of Development	77%	72%	69%

A Good Level of Development is defined as children working at the expected standard in the key areas of literacy, mathematics, physical development, communication and language and personal, social and emotional development.

### **Year One Phonic Screening**

### **Key Stage Two**

The results of the SATs (tests) are reported using a scaled score, where a score of 100 represents the expected standard. The highest possible score is 120 and the lowest is 80.

In addition to these measures and in line with requirements, we have reported the percentage of children achieving a High Standard. Children with a scaled score of 110 and above are included in this group. Year 6 pupils were assessed in reading, writing, grammar, punctuation and spelling, maths and science.

Children are awarded one of the following Teacher Assessment judgements in writing:

Expected Standard:	Working at the expected standard for their age
Greater Depth:	Working at greater depth within the expected standard and has a strong understanding of the curriculum
