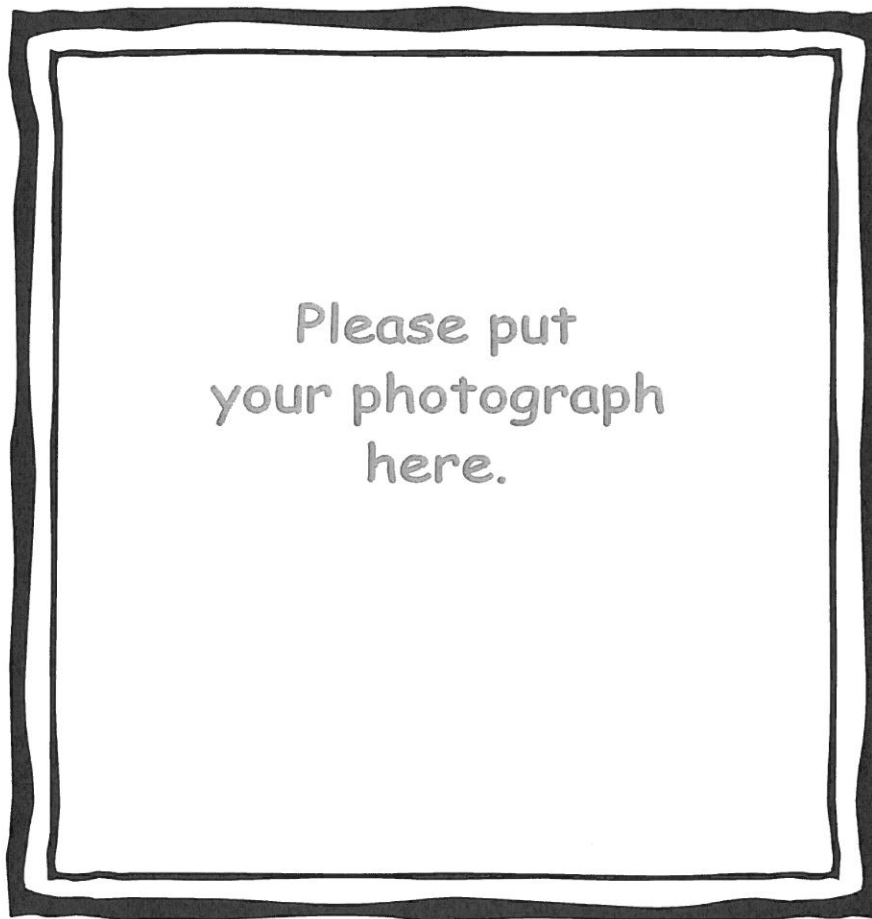


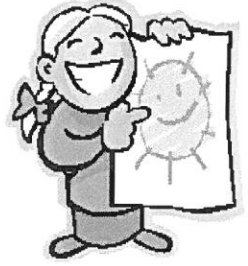

We have collected some activities for your child to complete over the summer break. We also would love you to add bits and pieces of your own on the blank pages. For example:

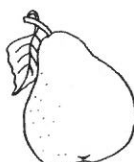
- 😊 A photo or drawing of a trip;
