

Who is entitled to Pupil Premium?

Your child and Corsham Primary School could be missing out on extra funding. Your approved registration could mean that your child is provided with extra support in school.

If you claim any of the benefits listed below you could be eligible:

- Income support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (not Working Tax Credit) with income less than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on
- Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Asylum Seekers Support
- Universal Credit

How is the funding used at Corsham Primary School?

- To provide a school meal
- To provide milk
- To provide support through 1:1 or small group TA interventions.
- Speech and language interventions
- Funds a Family Support Officer and Assistant
- Pastoral interventions (such as ELSA, block therapy and therapy dog)
- Run Breakfast Club

You may also be entitled to:

- Support with trips, residentials and clubs
- Food hampers

How much does each school receive?
