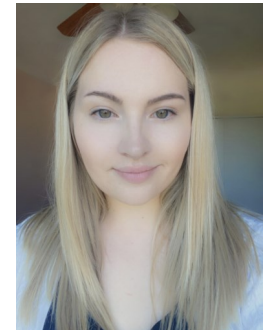

(engineering, product design, life cycles, human and physical geography, energy pollution, map skills and fieldwork, using tables to record and use data, instructions and debating, art using recycled materials)</p>	<p>Who is trading with whom? (local historical study, understanding trade, locational knowledge, history of merchant trading, researching using computers, map skills, design and make a trading board game)</p> <p>How can you show what you believe in? (sketching and sculpture, the Egyptians and Mayans, beliefs and faiths, historical research)</p>
