WALKING HOME ALONE AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL DAY

As we know, arrangements for collecting your children at the end of the school day can vary from time to time and kindly ask that when there is a change in these circumstances, you inform the class teacher as soon as possible. In an unforeseen situation, please telephone the school office to ensure that information about who is collecting your child that day can be passed to their class teacher.

In Key Stage Two, we recognise that children are becoming more independent and may wish to walk home alone or meet you at a point outside of school to then travel home together. Therefore, we request that written notification is provided, should you wish your child to walk home alone at the end of the day on a regular basis. This is to ensure that there is clarity between the child, the parents/carers and the school as we release them at home time.

Please fill in and return the form below to permit your child to leave school without an adult. Where children attend after school clubs, please ensure club leaders are also clear that you are happy for your child to walk home alone. Thank you.
