



Ivern's Before and After School Clubs Behaviour Code of Conduct

In line with our school Behaviour Policy, our wraparound care aims for every member of the school community to feel valued and respected as individuals, and for all persons to be treated fairly. We are a caring community, whose core values are built on mutual trust and compassion. Everyone is expected to take pride and maintain high levels of respect and show kindness to others.

We believe that before and after school child care should provide a relaxed, comfortable environment where children are encouraged to enjoy breakfast, play, socialise and create. In order to provide this type of environment, we have a flexible structure enabling the children to choose from many different activities. This is only possible if children accept the responsibility to follow these expectations, and we have your co-operation in impressing the importance of these guidelines.

Children attending Breakfast and After School Club are expected to:

- *Behave in an orderly, purposeful and sensible manner at all times*
- *Show courtesy, kindness and respect to all members of the Tree House club and after school club leaders*
- *Be thoughtful, helpful and understanding to each other*
- *Promote positive behaviour throughout their time at the club*

Our school golden rules will be displayed on the wall and referred to regularly.

Our adults leading our clubs will:

- *Welcome and greet children positively*
- *Refer to being 'Kind and Safe' in their play while at the club*
- *Model and promote positive behaviours by being calm*
- *Build respectful relationships.*
- *Support and facilitate activities that are engaging.*

Appropriate behaviour will be praised and rewarded in various ways including the granting of special privileges and rewards (praise, points, stickers).

If agreed codes of behaviour are broken, the following sanctions may be taken

- *Redirection/reminder of club expectations/rules to follow*
- *Warning (A chance given to make a better choice)*
- *Consequence (time out away from others for 5 minutes)*
- *Parents informed*

Extremely Poor Behaviour

Physical assault on another person, intentional damage to property, offensive language or open defiance of a member of staff may result in an immediate dismissal from the club. The parent may be responsible for reimbursing the club for the cost of damaged items.

Corsham Primary reserves the right to remove a pupil without notice should they engage in any of these behaviours.
