



Dear Parents and Carers

RE: Year Six PGL Osmington Bay Residential Trip 19, 20 and 21 October 2026

We are pleased to inform you that we have been busy planning the Year 6 PGL Residential for October 2026. For the last two years we have stayed with PGL at Osmington Bay, Weymouth, an excellent place to entertain 90 children, and we had a fantastic time. This residential is a fantastic opportunity for us all, with the children and adults returning to school with exciting stories of the challenges they faced and overcame.

Our trip for the next academic year will similarly take place on 19, 20 and 21 October 2026. The children will take part in a variety of activities such as water sports, giant swing, trapeze, archery and abseiling.

The total cost of the trip will be **£223.89** per child. This cost includes activities, all equipment and safety gear, food, accommodation, evening entertainment and transport and is broken down as follows:

Board & lodgings	£109.45
Activities	£89.55
Travel	£24.89*
Total:	£223.89

In light of a Trust wide review of our Charging and Remissions policy, *if your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, you will be eligible for free board and lodgings, please refer to Pickwick's [Charging and Remissions policy](#) on the website. Likewise, if you are in genuine financial difficulties and need support with the cost of the trip please contact the school office to arrange to speak to the Headteacher.*

To make the payments more manageable an instalment plan will be set up as follows:
