Trip to Warleigh Lodge Farm, Bathford
Apples - Wednesday 15th April 2026

Dear Parents/Carers

We plan to visit Warleigh Lodge Farm near Bathford on Wednesday 15th April. The Farm is a working farm which has been opened up to visitors as part of the Countryside Stewardship Scheme. We will have an opportunity to identify mini-beasts, trees, animals and flowers, look at habitats, feed the lambs and have a ride on a tractor and trailer. There will be no other visitors on the farm at the same time as us and we will be strictly following both the farm and coach company's safety procedures. We will be leaving from school at approximately 9.30am and will return by 3pm. The children can then go home in the usual way.

We are requesting a voluntary contribution of **£14.08 per pupil**. We are extremely grateful to Warleigh Lodge Farm who have been able to secure funding to allow them to reduce the admission fee for us on this occasion. Please be aware that this trip can only go ahead if we receive enough contributions. (Please note the DfE rules: "*Children of parents who are unable, or unwilling to contribute may not be discriminated against. However, if there are insufficient voluntary contributions made to cover the cost of the trip, or activity, and there is no alternative method to make up the shortfall, then the school should cancel the activity. Where there are not enough voluntary contributions, and there is no way to make up the shortfall, for example school funds and/or fundraising activities, then it must be cancelled*".)

- packed lunch and drink (no sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks please), if providing your own
- small back pack in which lunch and drink can be carried
- no spending money necessary
