High Temperatures expected this week

I hope you are well and enjoying the sunshine. With the extreme hot weather forecast for the week ahead, we will be putting several measures in place to help keep pupils safe, comfortable, and able to learn.

To support the wellbeing of all children, we will be making the following adjustments for the week ahead:

- Please don't send your child with a jumper or cardigan this week – they won't need it.
- Children should have a sun-hat: wide-brimmed is best! Sunglasses are optional.
- Please apply high-factor sun screen before school.
- We will limit time spent outdoors during peak heat and ensure shaded areas are used whenever possible.
- PE lessons and other physical activities will be adapted, moved indoors, or postponed.
- All classrooms will be kept as cool as possible with fans, open/closed windows, and blinds drawn where needed.
- Children will be encouraged to drink water regularly throughout the day; this means they will keep their drinks bottle on their desk or next to their seat. Please make sure your child has a filled bottle each morning.
- Staff will monitor pupils closely for signs of heat-related discomfort.

We will continue to monitor the weather and adjust our plans if needed.

Thank you for your support in helping us keep everyone safe and comfortable during this period of unusually high temperatures.
