

Mathematics: Consolidating knowledge of numbers to 20 using different contexts to develop understanding, such as counting money using the role-play area. We will be looking at correct number formation, developing experience of shape, measure and time.

Arts and Design: Developing skills using a variety of media and materials, including watercolours.

Understanding the World: Learn about changes from Spring to Summer.

Physical Development: Games, ball skills and preparing for Sports Day. Movement, response to music through a variety of opportunities to use and move our bodies.
