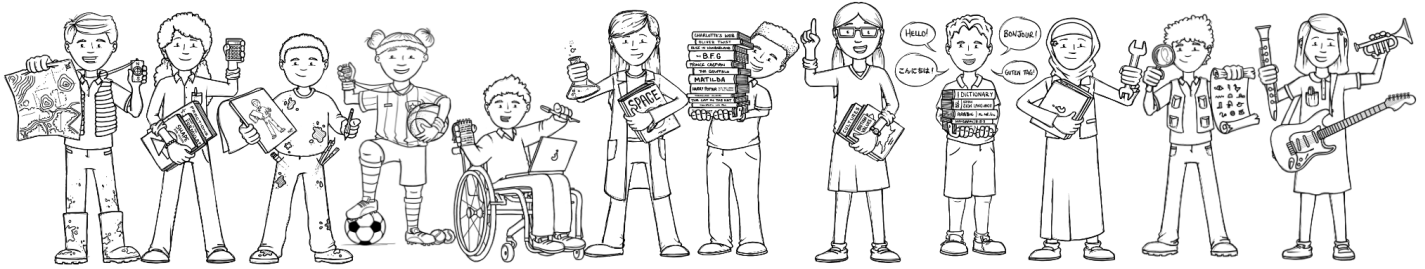


## Year 2
